## **BSAFE**

BSAFE is the online security awareness training. It is mandatory for ALL UN personnel: staff, interns, UN Volunteers. It is highly recommended for dependents.





## **<u>Prevention of Sexual Exploitation & Abuse</u>**

Become aware of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA), and a range of measures to combat such misconduct. Understand what the impact of SEA on victims is, and the consequences for UN Personnel who commit SEA.

## <u>United to Respect: Preventing Sexual Harassment & other</u> <u>Prohibited Conduct</u>

Learn about UN's policy and procedures on harassment with a focus on creating a harmonious working environment, free from intimidation, hostility, offence and any form of discrimination or retaliation.
